INSURED: Middlesex Hockey Umpires Association (plus various other Regional and County Associations) and any members of such associations or any umpire appointed by them.

BUSINESS The activities of Hockey Umpires Association (as more fully defined)

COVER: An indemnity against all sums for which the Insured shall be legally liable to pay as damages as a result of :

Public Liability:

- a) accidental bodily injury to or death illness or disease of any third party.
- b) accidental loss or damage to third party material property
- c) accidental obstruction trespass nuisance or interference with any right of way air or light water or other easements or false imprisonment

Products Liability:

- d) accidental bodily injury to or death illness or disease of any third party.
- e) accidental loss or damage to third party material property

caused by any commodity article or thing sold or supplied by the Insured

all arising out of the activities of an hockey umpires/umpiring association anywhere in the World.

Limit of Indemnity : £5,000,000 for any one occurrence or series of occurrences (and in all in respect of products liability).

Libel and Slander Extension:

an extension of cover to include liability incurred by the Insured arising from or caused by the publication or utterance by the Insured or on the Insured's behalf of a libel or slander.

Limit of Indemnity: £100,000 any one event.

Errors and Omissions Extension

An extension of cover to include liability incurred by the Insured as a result of errors or omissions in the conducts of the **BUSINESS**.

Limit of Indemnity: £100,000 any one period of insurance for any one insured association
(**N.B.** these extensions are on a 'claims made basis')

CLAIMS: All potential events likely to lead to a claim or any claim made should be notified (as soon as possible after an occurrence) to the Membership Secretary of M.H.U.A. for onward transmission.
