



MHUA – Development Committee – Terms of Reference

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Purpose: to provide a structure and direction for the umpiring development committee (“the committee”).

Composition and Membership:

The composition of the committee should be as follows:

The level 1 co-ordinator, the county coach the young umpire co-ordinator and appointments secretary. The committee can co-opt further members as necessary.

The chair of the meeting will be the level 1 co-ordinator. The members of the committee could therefore be changed by the actions at the annual MHUA AGM.

Experience and contact points for the committee members should include:

- Liaisons with club umpiring secretaries and their processes
- EH and the EH umpire development pathway
- SCHUA and the level 2 process
- SRYUAG and the young umpire pathway
- MHA and the equivalent to the junior academy, which would include the junior umpire pathway
- Leagues in which Middlesex clubs play
- MHUA appointment secretary and the process that they follow for Saturday and Sunday appointments

Responsibilities of the Committee:

- To work alongside the RYUAG, level 1 process, MHA and clubs to develop club, level 1 and young umpires, to develop umpiring within Middlesex for the benefit of the clubs and leagues.
- To develop the priorities and a strategy for umpire development within Middlesex. Initially this is suggested to target 3 areas (for simplicity) – young umpires, to assist clubs with their level 1 candidates, to develop umpires who can be appointed to MHUA games (men’s or women’s, league or cup matches).
- To look at a short term, medium and the long term strategy for umpire development.
- Development of umpire coaches
- Continued development of senior umpire assessors to ensure all Middlesex clubs (who are developing umpires) have at least one person who can operate in this capacity.

Reporting Structure:



The MHUA Development committee will report to the MHUA executive committee.

Meetings:

The MHUA Development Committee shall meet a minimum of 4 times a year by conference call or in person.
